Protection from Wildfires



- 97% of all wildfires are controllable
- 3% of wildfires overwhelm firefighters and get out of control
- The key to fire prevention is "Defensible Space"
- There are 6,000 parcels of property in Contra Costa County that are considered by the CC County Fire Prevention District to be in hazardous zones; none of these parcels is in Pleasant Hill
- The landscaping from 0 - 30ft (Zone1) around a house should be "low, clean and lean"
