Shel White gave “thumbs up” in happiness for his recovery from a nasty flu . . . after 4 miserable weeks.



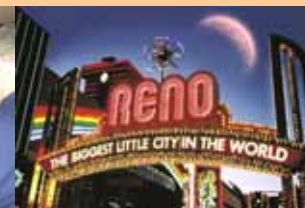
