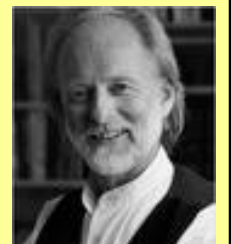

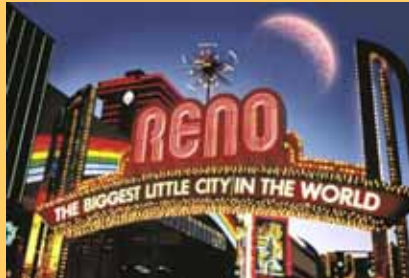
Mike Maxwell generously gave HD in tribute to his younger sister's reconciliation with the family after many years of estrangement.
