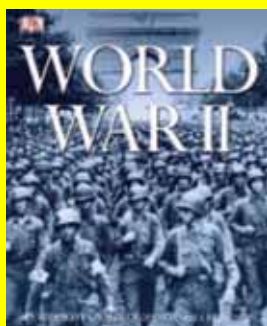

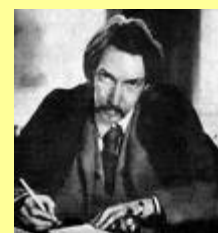

Ken Jacobson gave HD for his trip to Weed, California for golf; and to Klamath Falls.

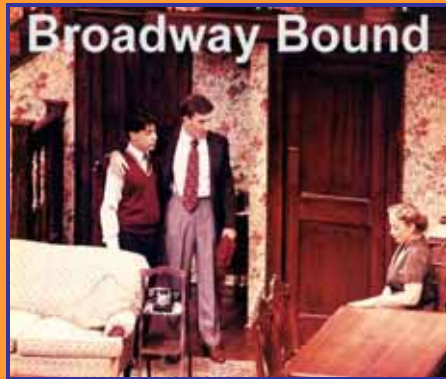


Michael Huguet gave HD to honor the great year Interact is having; and Alicia, the *fabulous* President the club has this year.
