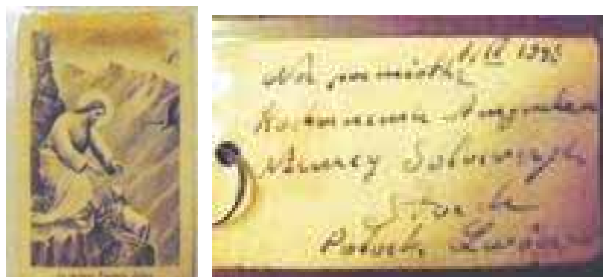
## ROTARIANS IN ACTION **LAST WEEK:**

Last week we had a very special program presented by George Primrose. George was a captain in the 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne Battalion during World War II. These is the battalion made famous by Stephen Ambrose in his book and later HBO series Band of Brothers.

*George is an American Hero, one of countless many who served our country during world war II. George recounted the many major battles the 101'st airborne engaged in, including D-Day, Operation Market Garden and the Battle of the Bulge. At the end of the war only 4 were left in George's squad of 12.*

*One of the most moving moments in George's presentation was when he recounted his time liberating those at the Landsberg Slave Labor Camp. A former prisoner presented him*

## WWI Remembrance



### George Primrose Author of "Lest We Forget"

"Lest We Forget," is a moving fictional account of World War II based on Budd and Mary's war-time experiences, has been published.

"Lest We Forget" is the story of Dan King, an 82 year-old airborne veteran of World War II, Betty, his English war-bride and their family.

During World War II, the 101st Airborne Division spent 214 days in combat. In addition to the 2 Medals of Honor to Soldiers of the 101st, the Division awarded 47 Distinguished Service Crosses, 516 Silver Stars and 6,977 Bronze Stars. The Division was responsible for capturing 29,527 enemy soldiers. The price of victory was high. 2,043 Screaming Eagles were killed in action and 7,976 were wounded. 1,193 became MIA and 336 were taken prisoner.
