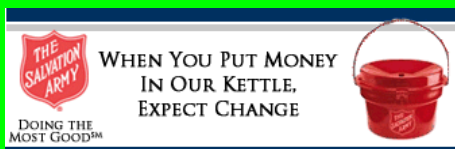

EIGHT POINTS TO YOUR BLUE BADGE **– To be accomplished within 3 months of induction:**

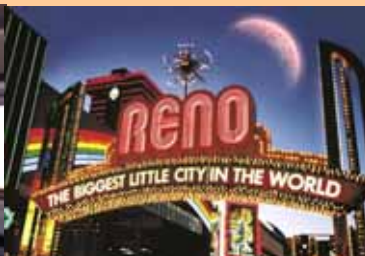
