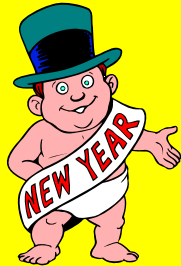

Jim Alkire gave MAJOR HD for his trip to Tucson and in tribute to Arizona University's win over USC!



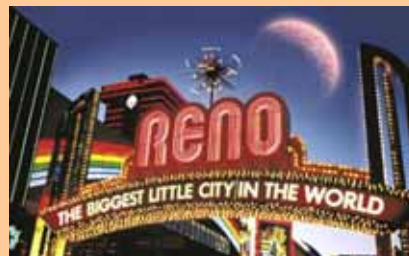
