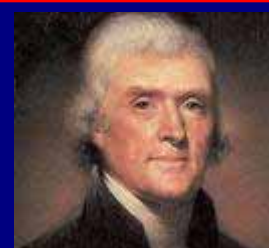
Interact: Prez Jim also would like to involve Interact in our club activities; and nominate a PH resident as a GSE scholar or for a youth exchange.

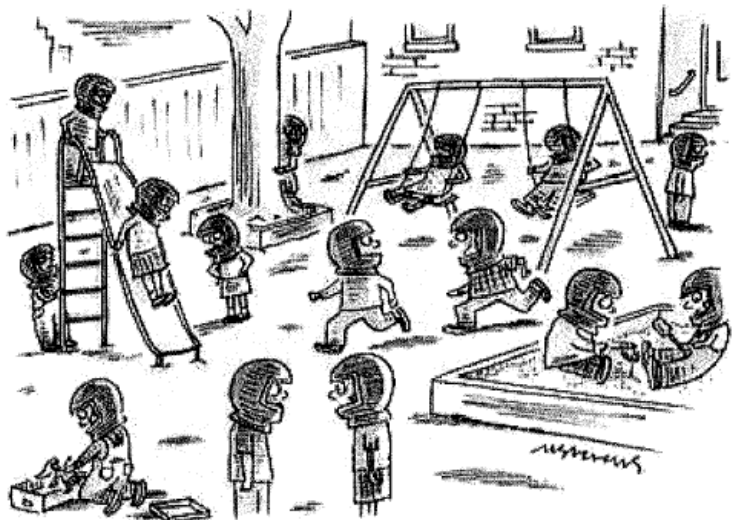
