Jim Alkire donated HD for the opportunity to bestow a \$2 white Michigan Cap on Michigan Alum Dave Tittle.



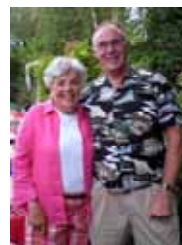
Pete Dunbar donated HD for retirement of Jeremy Roenick from the San Jose Sharks.

Sun Lee was born in Korea and came to Berkeley in 2001 to study Human Rights and Post Colonial Literature. She applied to Rotary International for an Ambassadorial Scholarship to study languages.

She chose French and was selected to go to the Language Institute in Tours, France for 6 months. Studying in a foreign country not only taught her the language but also allowed her to submerge herself into the culture and learn about the people and why they do what they do.

She stayed with host families during her time in France, which presented challenges and learning experiences as an Asian/American. During her stay, she was afforded opportunities to work with community service projects. Sun Lee also attended weekly Rotary meetings and spoke to the members about America while exchanging views about cultural differences.

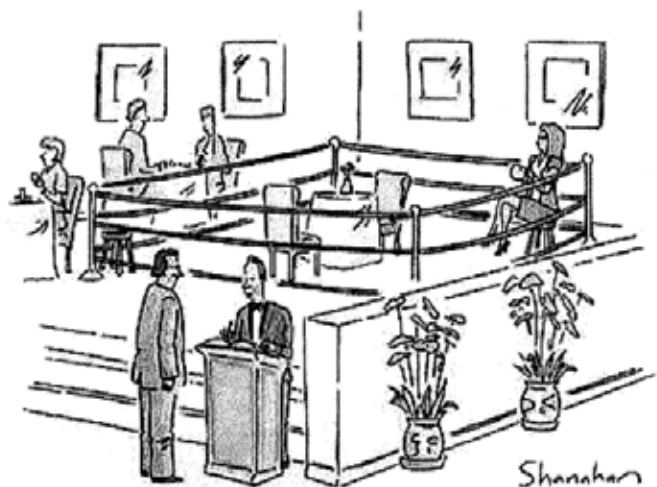
