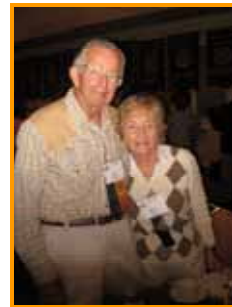
## ☺Happy Times & Happy Dollars☺

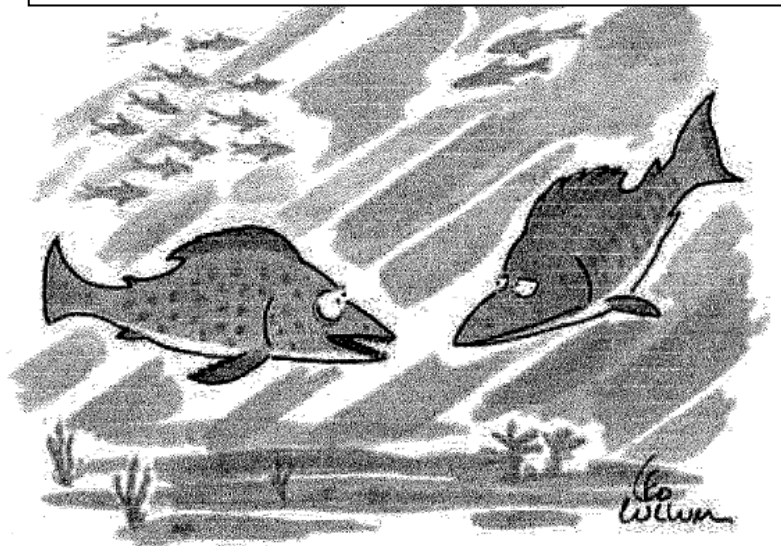

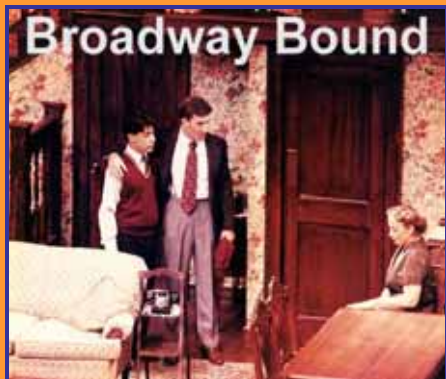

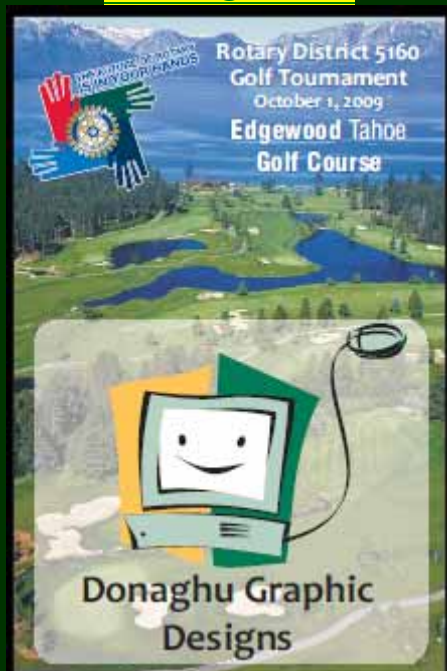
